




Outhaul secured

up the length of line.





(Above) The outhaul can be a simple permanent lashing, but rig a small block and tackle if you want to adjust it quickly.

(Right) The parts of a mainsail.



Tack + tack pin

Boat trapped, no sail - until tack
tack down and draft around port



Two half-hitches - use on outhaul

"Night knot" = two half-hitches on a bight (a loop instead of a single length)

Cleat hitch - use on halyard and anywhere there is a horn cleat.
